PUBLIC PRESENTERS

Stanton Viking Center Director, Justin Miller, was present. He updated the Board that the Viking Center and the Stanton Community Foundation have been working on updating and expanding the Little League Field at Danny Anderson Park. He asked the Board if the school would be interested in having them also do research and bring back information on costs and concepts for making improvements to the school's softball field to bring it to regulation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion by Tibben, second by Ward to approve consent agenda of past minutes, reports, bills and personnel. All in favor. Motion passed.

Under personnel, the Board approved the hiring of Lacey Stephens as Assistant Girls Basketball Coach, Noel Bogdanski and Kelsi Bruce as Driver's Education Teachers, and Rene Zenor as Kindergarten Teacher while Lisa Smith student teaches in the classroom.

Director Cameron Lewellen was present at 6:13 p.m. Director Tibben left the meeting at 6:15 p.m.

SUPERINTENDENT UPDATE

Under facilities update, Gute updated the Board that there will be a Strategic Planning Committee meeting on Thursday, November 9, 2023 for the STEM/Science Room renovation project.

Gute stated that Jake Ashley is still getting quotes for an HVAC system for the locker rooms. Gute indicated that he would like to have carpet replaced in the hall ways in the near future.

Under Stanton School softball field discussion, the consensus of the Board was to collaborate with the Stanton Viking Center and Stanton Community Foundation in the research of making improvements to the school's field. Miller stated that he will bring back more information to the Board for further discussion.

After discussion, motion by Ward, second by Lewellen to purchase a Kubota L2501HST (tractor) with an LA526 loader, a STB0560 (front mount snow blade), and a PFL1242(front mount pallet forks) in the total amount of \$25,450 from Whipps Sales and Service. All in favor. Motion passed.

Motion by Lewellen, second by Ward to approve the Sharing Agreement between Stanton Community School District and Fremont-Mills Community School District for Guidance Counselor for 2023-2024 school year. All in favor. Motion passed.

Motion by Lewellen, second by Ward to approve the Sharing Agreement between Stanton Community School District and Fremont-Mills Community School District for Curriculum Director for the 2023-2024 school year. All in favor. Motion passed.

Gute distributed School Policies (402.3-405.9 & 503.7) for the first reading, revisions and review. Motion by Lewellen, second by Ward to approve Stanton Community School Policies, (400-402.2 &705.2). All in favor. Motion passed.
