Dear Parents/Guardians:

We have been notified by Montgomery County Public Health (MCPH) of an additional positive case of COVID-19 in the Stanton Community School District. The individuals listed as close contacts who need to quarantine will be notified by MCPH within 24 hours. MCPH will also contact those individuals who were in close contact while wearing masks and will ask those individuals to monitor their symptoms.

We continue to monitor the COVID situation in Montgomery County and surrounding counties/communities. Our cleaning staff continues to diligently clean and disinfect our building daily, and we will continue with our current mask mandate for all students and staff. We ask that parents/guardians continue to monitor their student's health. The symptoms associated with COVID include fever/chills, loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, cough, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, muscle or body aches, or headache. Anyone with these symptoms needs to contact a physician. Please contact Montgomery County Public Health if you have any additional questions regarding contact tracing or quarantine requirements.
