OCTOBER 11, 2023 REGULAR BOARD MEETING

The Stanton School District Board of Directors met at 5:45 PM on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at the High School Library for a regular session. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion by Tibben, second by Ward to approve consent agenda of past minutes, reports, bills and personnel. All in favor. Motion passed.

Under personnel, the Board approved the hiring of Ann Zaiger as MS/HS Science Teacher for .75 time.

Under transportation, Gute shared that there was an annual transportation inspection and all fleet passed. Bus drivers recently attended mandatory annual classes.

SUPERINTENDENT UPDATE

Gute gave a facilities update. He shared with the Board that he met with Jake Ashley and Adam Wenberg and directed them to compile a list of facility needs that they consider a priority. Some projects discussed were replacing hallway carpet and locker room upgrades. Gute stated that he has received estimates for a new fire alarm system. This could cost up to \$325,000 depending on what features are included. Gute shared a quote that he received from Jake Ashley for a new tractor. The John Deere quote included options for purchasing or leasing equipment. The Board would like other quotes from different businesses for comparison. Gute is still working on obtaining cost estimates from KPE Architecture Engineering Forensics.

Principal Elwood reported on PTSO, Booster Club and student activities. She distributed ISASP Scores and FAST Date reports.
