American Legion Flag Essay Contest

The American Legion sponsors an annual flag essay contest for fifth-graders nation-wide. Each fifth-grader is invited to write a 300-word essay about what the American flag means to them. They are encouraged to personalize their essays and to include flag facts and information they've learned from the Flag Code. Starting at a local level, essays are scored on originality, logic, facts/comprehension, and grammar/spelling. The winning essay at the local level advances to the district, and so on. Although only the first-place winner advances to the next level, the local American Legion Post #406 awards prize money to the top three essay writers. This year's winners were: 3rd place, Wesley Mainquist; 2nd place, Aubrey Erickson; 1st place, Owen Gettler. Owen's essay went on to district, where he won second place, earning another cash prize.
