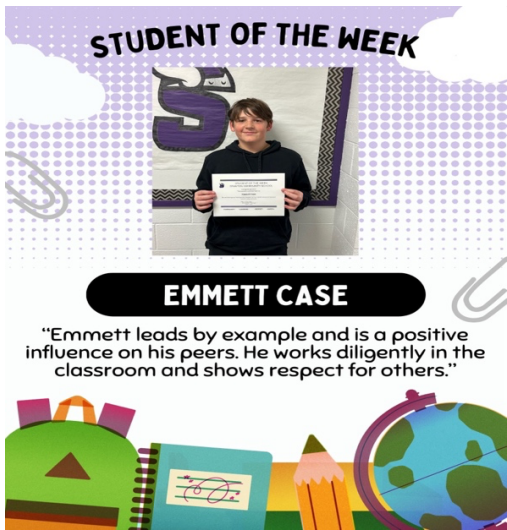
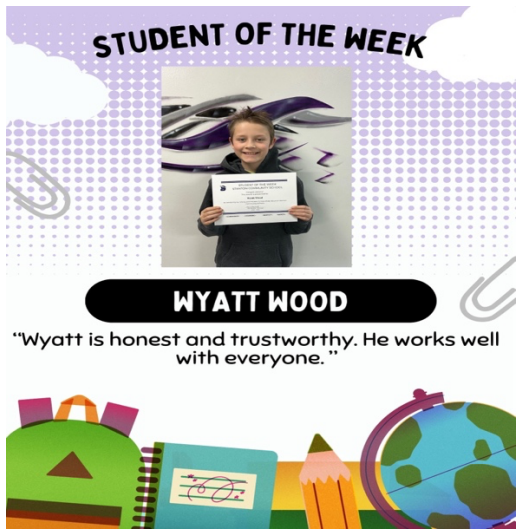

FFA Agriscience Fair

Five Stanton FFA members competed in the Iowa FFA Agriscience Fair and the State Science and Technology Fair of Iowa this past week. Clark received 2nd place in Division 5 Environmental Systems in the FFA Agriscience Fair, a \$1000 ISU College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Scholarship, the US Metric Association Award, and he received his plaque and prize for having been a science fair participant for 7 years. Clark's senior year project was entitled: Analysis of the Effects of Particulate Matter on Photosynthetically Active Radiation Levels in Iowa

Addison received 2nd place in Division 1 Plant Systems in the FFA Agriscience Fair. Addison also received the Naval Sciences Award. Addison's project was: Dahlia Variety Response to Propagation. Braydon received 3rd place in Division 1 Power and Structural Systems in the FFA Agriscience Fair. Braydon's project title was: Burn Temperatures of Various Wood Types. Grant presented his project on potting mixes in Division 3 Plant Systems in the FFA Agriscience Fair. Grant's project is a 5 year continuation project entitled: Growing Media Comparison on Plant Root Growth. Logan presented his project working with concrete in Division 1 Power and Structural Systems. Logan's project was: The Strength of Concrete.

A great group of students - they all put in a lot of hours and hard work on their research projects.

Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference

The 97th Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference will be held on April 14th and 15th. The Stanton FFA Chapter will have numerous members competing; performing with the State Band; receiving awards, degrees and recognition; and serving as delegates for the Business Session.

Two members have been selected to perform with the Iowa FFA State Band. Those members are Nick Herrick performing with the trombone, and Gabe Kingery performing with trumpet. They will be performing during both the 3rd and 4th General Sessions.

After placing 1st place Gold on the District Discovery Test, Addison Spencer will be taking the State Discovery Quiz. Clark Spencer will be competing in the State Extemporaneous Speaking Leadership Development Event. He will also be recognized for being the 1st place overall individual for the State Soils Evaluation Career Development Event this past fall. Clark will receive his 1st Place State Proficiency Award in the area of Agriscience - Integrated Systems on stage during the 1st Session.

Clark has also been named one of sixteen total and one of four in his area to be named a Stars Over Iowa candidate. During the convention he will be interviewed in his respective area of Agriscience. At the 4th General Session on Tuesday Clark will be performing the National Anthem to begin the session and will be recognized in the Stars Over Iowa Pageant for his Supervised Agricultural Experience in the area of Agriscience.

Clark Spencer and Ella Peterson will both be receiving their Iowa FFA Degree, the highest degree bestowed upon a member at the state level, at the 4th General Session.
