JH Track

On Friday, May 1st, both the boys and girls junior high track teams continued to shine on the oval and in field events. Of the 10-team field in both divisions, the girls placed second and the boys placed third.

Top 3 finishers were as follows:

On the boys side, Alek Green placed 2nd in the 100m with his new personal best of 13.30, in the 400m Alek placed first, in the 100 m hurdles, Noah Marsh set a new personal best of 15.35 and also raced to a first place finish in the 200m hurdles, the 4 x 100 team (Owen R, Zak P, Owen G and Deacon S) placed third, the sprint medley team (Decklan M, Owen R, Jack J, Deacon S) placed second, the shuttle hurdle team (Cylin W, Owen G, Deacon S, Noah M) placed first, Noah dominated the shot put event with another winning throw, Zak P placed second in the discus, Cylin won the high jump and Jack Johnson placed second in the long jump with a leap of 17-0.50. Many of the individual and team events were bests for the season so far. In the girls division, Natalie Ward placed 2nd with her best run of 1:06.20, Cameo French won the 100m hurdles, Gracelyn placed third in the 200m hurdles, the 4 x 100 team (Lucy, Lily, Ally and Cameo) set a best of 57.83, the 4 200 (Lili FS, Harper A, Anna L, Andee A) placed second, the 4 x 400 (Mia G, Gracelyn M, Payton F and Natalie W) won the event, the sprint medley team (Ally W, Harper A, Lucy D, Natalie W) placed first, the distance medley team of Andee A, Harper A, Ally W and Payton F put in their best of the season performance for second place, the shuttle hurdle team (Lucy D, Mia G, Gracelynn M, Cameo F) set their best time of the season 1:16.36 for first place honors, Gracelynn placed third in the shot put, and Lucy won the high jump.

The team is back in action at Corning on Friday night and will be at Griswold on Monday. We are looking forward to another rewarding week of track!
